
# A book for F.2: A Journey to the Centre of the Earth




#### Book recommendation

- Arthur C. Clarke once said, 'The reason Verne is still read by millions today is simply that he was one of the best storytellers who ever lived.'
- The story starts with an adventurous geology professor who chances upon a manuscript in which a 16th-century explorer claims to have found a route to the earth's core. The expedition descends into an extinct volcano toward a sunless sea, where they encounter a subterranean world of luminous rocks, antediluvian forests, and fantastic marine life -a living past that holds the secrets to the origins of human existence.
- Originally published in 1864, Jules Verne's classic remains critically acclaimed for its style and imaginative visions. Verne wrote many fantasy stories that later proved remarkably prescient, and his distinctive combination of realism and romanticism exercised a lasting influence on writers as diverse as Mark Twain, Arthur Conan Doyle, and Jean-Paul Sartre.
- In addition to the excitement of an action novel, Journey to the Center of the Earth has the added appeal of a psychological quest. This book also inspires scientific fantasy and students' thinking about where humankind evolves.

- Praised by The New York Times as "a true singer of the people white or black," Paul Laurence Dunbar published this short story collection in 1904, two years before his untimely death.
- As a historic collection of perceptive tales from a luminary of nineteenth-century literature, this book features sixteen short stories that provide rare glimpses into the lives of African Americans after the Civil War.
- In this collection, readers meet an influential entrepreneur who must navigate a treacherous political landscape; a Southern spiritual leader who must learn to accept the mores of his son, who was educated in the North; a reporter who restores hope in Santa Claus to a group of destitute siblings; and a host of other unique men and women giving voice to timeless themes.
- A captivating read, The Heart of Happy Hollow will introduce more book lovers to this revered storyteller and visionary.
