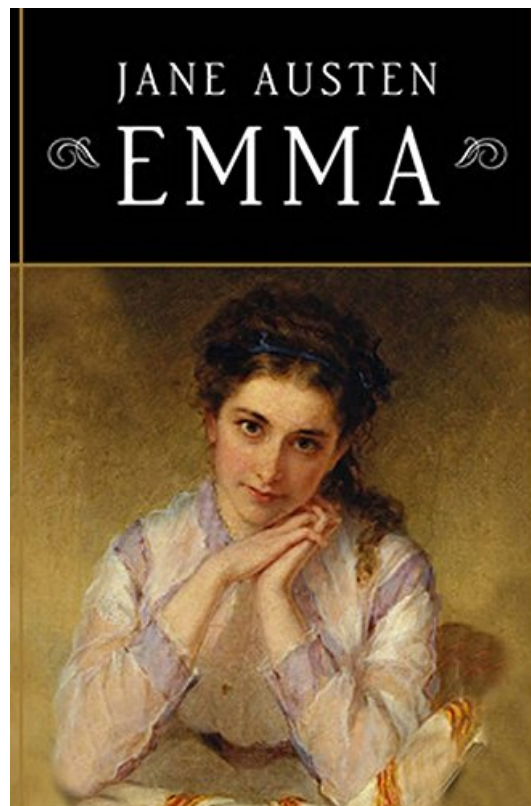

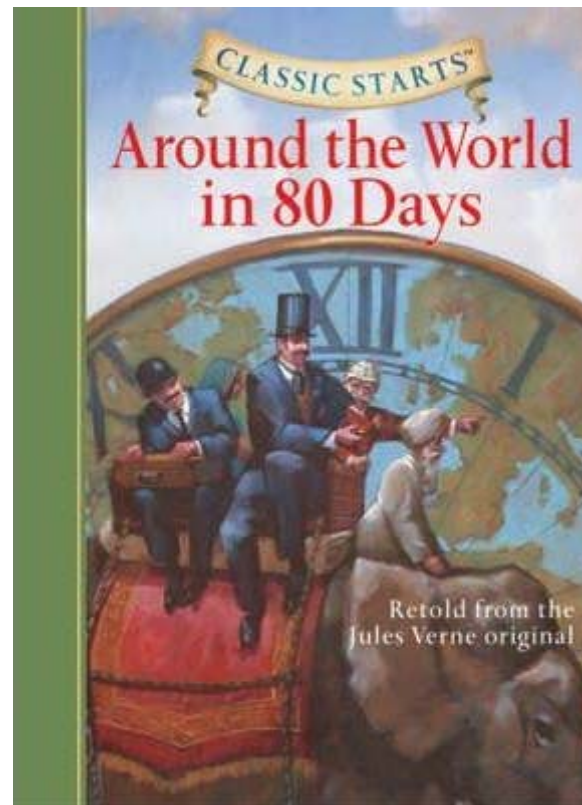
# Book recommendation

- Emma Woodhouse is one of Austen's most captivating and vivid characters. Beautiful, spoilt, vain and irrepressibly witty, Emma organizes the lives of the inhabitants of her sleepy little village and plays matchmaker with devastating effect.
- Marriage and social status are the two foci of Emma. Most of the drama in Austen's novel revolves around who loves whom and what that means, given their social status.
- Such a stereotype might have been buried in the past. Yet, this classic does shed some light on the search for a level-playing field in society. Is there any bias or discrimination to be rectified or resolved in the modern times?

# 書本介紹
